Who belongs to RTO/ERO?

We have over 70,000 members, from age 45 to 109, from every facet of education.

Can I join RTO/ERO?

Yes, if you had a full career in education as a teacher, school or board administrator receiving a pension from the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan, you will be a full member.

If you are college and university faculty, and support staff from schools and school boards, you will be an associate member.

Remember if you are actively employed in education you can also join RTO/ERO. Contact us for more details.

How does RTO/ERO operate?

We are organized into 46 Districts in Ontario and two in British Columbia. We have a Provincial Office, where 20 professional staff members support the work of Senate (RTO/ERO's governing body), the Provincial Executive, provincial committees and Districts.

your group insurance

- ✓ Choose from a variety of comprehensive plans: Dental, Extended Health Care (**including travel coverage**), Semi-Private Hospital and Convalescent Care, and Supplemental Travel;
- ✓ For those couples where both are retiring from education, **only the primary applicant** must be a member of RTO/ERO to obtain couple coverage;
- ✓ Everyone receives the same coverage and benefits at any age;
- ✓ Owned and managed by RTO/ERO members, which gives you a voice in shaping your group insurance plans;
- ✓ Over 86,000 participants – the largest group insurance plan for retired educators and support staff in Canada;
- ✓ Services under our group insurance include: direct payment to pharmacies; electronic submission of dental, vision and paramedical practitioner claims; direct deposit of claims payments; web access to real-time claims information; and electronic communications;
- NEW** ✓ Through Eldercare Select, Extended Health Care participants have access to 24/7 nurse-led guidance of our health care system and care giving support, addressing specific eldercare challenges with customized action plans.
- ✓ In addition to our group insurance plans, we offer a complete suite of individual plans, including Long Term Care, Term Life, Guaranteed Life and Home-Auto.

Full membership (teachers, school and board administrators)

In the second year of membership your fee is \$1.25 per \$1,000 of gross annual pension, deducted annually* by the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan (OTPP), except for retired teachers with a minimum of 15 years of credited service who opted for a commuted value transfer from OTPP; they pay the average fee collected from full members receiving a pension from OTPP*

**Please note that when you first join RTO/ERO you will be required to provide a membership fee which must be paid before your application is processed. This fee is based on the month in which you join and the amount is the average full members' fees. Your annual deduction from the OTPP pension begins in your second calendar year of membership.*
