

What does it cost to belong to RTO/ERO?

Full membership fee is \$1.20 per \$1000 or major fraction thereof, of gross annual pension.

Example: \$40,000 pension will result in \$48.00 annual fee.

Associate membership fee is \$43.00 annually. Associate memberships are for retired educators who are ineligible to receive a pension from the Ontario Teachers' Pension Fund.
