HOW TO JOIN RTO/ERO

It is NOT automatic. You must apply!

Whether you are about to retire or have already retired, once you leave the school system we have no way to contact you. To join our mailing list and receive further information, you must contact our Membership Chair, Jeff Milan or Toronto to receive an information package to join District 27 of RTO/ERO.

There is a separate form if you wish to apply for Group Health Benefits, if you are not covered by another group plan.

Membership Fees are calculated at a rate of \$1.25 per \$1000 of your gross annual pension.

For most people the fee ranges from \$40 to \$75 a year and is deducted from your January pension.

District membership is included in your Provincial membership

RTO/ERO GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM

This program is owned and managed by you, the members of RTO/ERO. 60,000 RTO/ERO members and their families belong to this plan which is administered by Johnson Inc.
